Insect-Station

The population of flying insects is in sharp decline. Natural food sources are continuing to dwindle. Yet bees, bumblebees, butterflies, wild bees, and even wasps are vital for pollinating plants and maintaining the ecological balance.

Our patented *Insect-Station* serves as both a watering hole and a feeding station. Flying insects are attracted by the blue paint. The included sponge in the center is soaked in syrup (e.g., sugar water*) as a nectar substitute. Solid food (e.g., fruit pieces) can be placed on the inner rim. The surrounding water channel serves as a watering station and simultaneously protects the food from ants.

* Werner's Special Syrup

Our neighbor Werner is a beekeeper and makes a special syrup for feeding his bees in the fall: Boil a cup of chamomile tea with two tea bags and stir in sugar equal to 1/3 of the water volume. And there you have it—Werner's Special Syrup, which isn't just a treat for bees.

Added Value for Insect Conservationists

We include five cellulose sponges. If the sponge is kept moist on a regular basis, it can be used for one season. Depending on sun exposure, the sponge may lose its color, but this does not affect its function. Replacement sponges can be purchased at cosmetic stores or directly from us. Used sponges can be disposed of as waste paper.

If you place the *Insect-Station* about 4m away from your garden table and stock it with appropriate food, wasps and bees will much prefer to rest there. You can then enjoy coffee and cake undisturbed.



Easy Cleaning

In the summer, the *Insect-Station* should be cleaned every three days. To do this, use a soft brush and a small amount of mild soap. Then rinse thoroughly.

Frost-Resistant Ceramic

Insects need food and water from spring through fall. If the water channel freezes during the cold months, this will not damage the ceramic.

Stand for the Insect-Station

We also offer an optional stainless steel stand for the *Insect-Station*. This raises the insect station off the ground, making it easier to place in the garden or on a garden table.
