The Storage Bowl

The Storage Bowl, made of breathable CeraNatur® ceramic, is designed for natural storage of fruit and vegetables. The storage bowl protects its contents against light, and ensures good air circulation so that no condensation forms. The ceramic neither absorbs nor gives off odours.

The Storage Bowl is handmade in our workshops in Coburg, Germany, to a consistently high-quality standard. The base features felt pads to protect your surface.

It comes with two connectable dividers made of natural, solid beech, to create four separate storage areas in the bowl. The bowl can be divided into two larger areas by using just one divider. The wood comes from Franconian forests and is PEFC-certified.

We also include a cover made of high-quality Upper Lusatian linen, with sewn-in elastication. This linen rapidly absorbs and releases moisture.



Natural Storage

Keep the *Storage Bowl* out of direct light and in the coolest part of your kitchen, larder or cellar. It is designed for storing fruit and vegetables for one to two weeks.

The connectable beech wood dividers enable to the bowl to be divided up into separate sections. Beech is very hard, which makes it ideal for use in direct contact with foods, so you can store carrots right next to onions or potatoes.

Food stored in the *Storage Bowl* must be dry and clean. Please make sure that none of the fruit or vegetables are rotten. Contents should be checked every two to three days. Remove any rotten fruit or vegetables.

Please only store apples with other fruit and vegetables for a short time. Apples must be stored individually if they require storage for longer. However, different varieties of apple can be stored together.

Use and Care

To improve air-circulation, we have developed a breathable version of our ceramic for the Storage Bowl. However, this ceramic cannot be waterproof at the same time.

The ceramic shimmers in shades of beige and brown. One piece might have darker and lighter areas, as well as black speckles. These special, individual features emphasise the natural processes used in production and are not grounds for complaint.

Treatment of the wooden parts

Moisture or pressure can cause untreated beech wood to distort. This is a natural process and not cause for complaint.

We therefore recommend rubbing a thin layer of olive oil into all sides (including the edges) twice before use. This will reduce the risk of the wood becoming distorted and stop dirt from getting into it.

Cleaning

Clean the ceramic bowl with water, a brush and washing-up liquid. It should then be air-dried for around two days.

The linen cover can be machine-washed at up to 60° C if required. It is not suitable for tumble drying.

Wooden parts that have been treated with olive oil can be wiped with a damp cloth. Place them on their side, or connected together, on a flat surface to dry.
